SUBJECT: CONFIRMATORY ACTION LETTER

The purpose of this letter is to relieve you of your commitment to refrain from processing the Teledyne Wah Chang material without prior notification to, and approval from this office. Your commitment was confirmed in our letter to you, same subject, dated June 8, 1992. This relief from your commitment is effective 10 days from the date of issuance of this letter.

The basis for this release is our evaluation of information concerning the USEPA Toxicity Characteristic Leaching Procedure (TCLP) test obtained from the State of Oregon, and from you, which verifies that the material does not classify as a RCRA hazardous waste. This reconfirms the basis for our issuance on June 2, 1992, of Amendment 30 to your NRC license.
